RECALL PETITION INSTRUCTION SHEET

PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS:

You may print or copy as many blank petitions as you wish. Make sure to print blank petition on **legal size paper (8.5 x 14)**. Do not alter the size of the petition. Make sure to photocopy **BLANK** petitions from an original (clean) printed version of the petition. **DO NOT write or print on the back of the petition.**

California law provides very strict guidelines on obtaining valid recall petition signatures. Signatures or petitions that do not follow these guidelines are “invalid” and will not be counted. Please follow the instructions carefully.

General Rules

- All signatures on a petition must be by REGISTERED VOTERS of the SAME County that is designated on the petition. Use separate petitions for each different county.
- If you are not registered to vote you may fill out a voter registration form and send it in and then immediately thereafter sign the recall petition.
- The person who circulates the petition, even if you only circulate it to yourself, must sign each petition at the bottom.

Instructions

- 1) Make sure to fill in the County in which you reside (Los Angeles or San Bernardino). Only people registered to vote in the 59th Assembly District can sign, or circulate, a petition. Each petition must contain signatures for registered voters from the SAME county.
- 2) **Print** your name and address, and **sign** your name in the space provided. You can only sign one petition, but you can get other registered voters to sign the petition.
- 3) Additional registered voters may complete a box by **printing** their name and address and **signing** in the space provided. All signers on a petition form must be **registered voters** of the 59th Assembly District, and live in the county designated in part 1.
- 4) In the box “DECLARATION OF CIRCULATOR” you must fill in all shaded areas in your own handwriting. Follow the instructions carefully to avoid rejection of the petition
- 5) Make sure to **sign** the Signature of Circulator box.

REMEMBER:

- Only **registered** voters of the **59th Assembly District** may sign and circulate petitions.
- You may circulate as many petitions as you wish, however, you can only sign the petition for recall **once**.
- You can circulate petitions in more than 1 County (Los Angeles or San Bernardino), but all signers of each petition must be from the **same** County. Start a new petition for each County
- A petition is valid even with **one** signature.

PETITION FOR RECALL

TO THE HONORABLE Secretary of State of California, Pursuant to the California Constitution and California election laws, we the undersigned registered and qualified electors of the 59th Assembly District of Los Angeles and San Bernardino Counties, California, respectfully state that we seek the recall and removal of Anthony Adams, holding the office of State Assemblyman, in State Assembly District 59, California.

We demand an election of a successor to that office.

The following Notice of Intention to Circulate Recall Petition was served on April 8, 2009.

TO THE HONORABLE Assemblyman Anthony Adams: Pursuant to Section 11020, California Elections Code, the undersigned registered qualified voters of Assembly District 59, in the State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and we intend to seek your recall and removal from the office of Member of the Assembly of the State of California, and to demand election of a successor in that office by the voters.

The grounds for the recall are as follows:

Anthony Adams broke his solemn word and raised our taxes. He was elected based on this signed guarantee:

I, Anthony Adams, pledge to the taxpayers of the 59th AD district of the state of California and to all the people of this state, that I will oppose and vote against any and all efforts to increase taxes.

Adams betrayed us and broke his promise on February 19, 2009, by casting one of the deciding votes to increase income taxes, increase sales taxes, and nearly doubled the car tax.

Californians already pay our share. We have the highest state taxes in the country, but because representatives like Adams can't say no to special interests and control spending, our economy is suffering. If Sacramento controlled spending to match inflation and population growth, there would be more than enough revenue. Raising taxes in a recession further burdens the private sector, drives more jobs out of the State, and prolongs the recession. Adams knows this. He was elected on his promise not to raise taxes but took the easy Sacramento way by caving into the special interests and raising taxes.

Adams broke his tax pledge. Adams must go. Visit RecallAdams.org.

The answer of the officer sought to be recalled is as follows:

The petition you hold is the creation of two very wealthy Orange County men who care less about our community and more about their own political ambitions. They want us to pay \$900,000 in our hard earned tax dollars to pay for another election and their partisan political games.

They are helping to bankroll an effort to recall our local Assemblyman Anthony Adams because Adams stood with taxpayers and working families and against their reckless agenda.

What did Assemblyman Adams do wrong? He stood with us and not them. Here's proof.

Adams voted for \$15 billion in permanent spending reductions, for a real spending limit, and a rainy day fund to prevent further tax increases.

Adams fought against and prevented a proposed 12-cent increase to our gasoline tax.

Adams put Californians back to work by freeing \$1.6 billion in transportation projects that had been shut down by government gridlock.

Adams promoted jobs by supporting tax credits to hire new workers in our community.

The California State Sheriff's Association opposes the recall because they know Adams stepped up to stop early release of prisoners.


